Charleston County, South Carolina is considering an ordinance which would prohibit smoking in all county-owned and operated buildings. The Tobacco Institute has asked that our sales people in that area write letters to the members of council to express their displeasure with the proposal. In addition, it would be most helpful if some of our sales people or distributors appeared at the public hearing on this matter scheduled for January 5.
