Republicans pick up one congressional seat, Ed Schrock. Cantor, Joanne Davis and George Allen all won as expected.

Kentucky

No changes in Senate or House power structure. Senate Republicans still maintains control by two seats. House Democrats lost a few seats but have a large majority. Republican Congressman Ann Northup won as expected.

North Carolina

Democrat Mike Easley won the Governors race. Democrate Beverly Perdue won Lt. Governor. Democrat Roy Cooper won Attorney General. Senate stayed Democrat, and as of 9:15 a.m., House remains Democrat by 62 to 58. However, there are three seats two democrats one republican, all within a 200 vote margin.

South Carolina

House remains GOP and picked up several seats. Senate as of 9:15 a.m. this morning is 23-23, with the tie breaking vote going to the Republican Lt. Governor. 37th District is still up for grabs. If it goes democratic, democrats will remain in control.
